



R&R: OUR REVIEW & REFRESH PROGRAM

The R&R Program (“Review and Refresh Program”) is designed to build on the Orientation and initial training done during a CAREGiver’s first two days with Home Instead. Because time limits the discussion of individual topics during the virtual “school days,” we have developed a follow-up.

The R&R program allows CAREGivers to review learning about and refresh their understanding of assigned subjects. This is accomplished through our online training resource, “Empower.”

- ④ **Upon completing Orientation and initial training, you are given a schedule of 6 Empower learning assignments,** one assignment to be completed per week for each of the first 6 weeks of employment.
- ④ **In addition, you participate in 3 virtual roundtable discussions on the assigned topics:**
 - Discussion 1, COVID & Universal Precautions
 - Discussion 2, Dementia
 - Discussion 3, Parkinson’s Disease, Diabetes and Stroke

Simply call your local office to schedule the discussions you want to attend. These discussions can be done most anywhere from a smart phone, tablet, or computer. Various discussion sessions are available to meet different schedules. The training calendar can be viewed at homeinsteadconnect.com.

- ④ **Track your progress on the game card** provided and return the card to the franchise office when all video assignments and discussion sessions have been completed. Completion is verified and you receive an incentive reward!



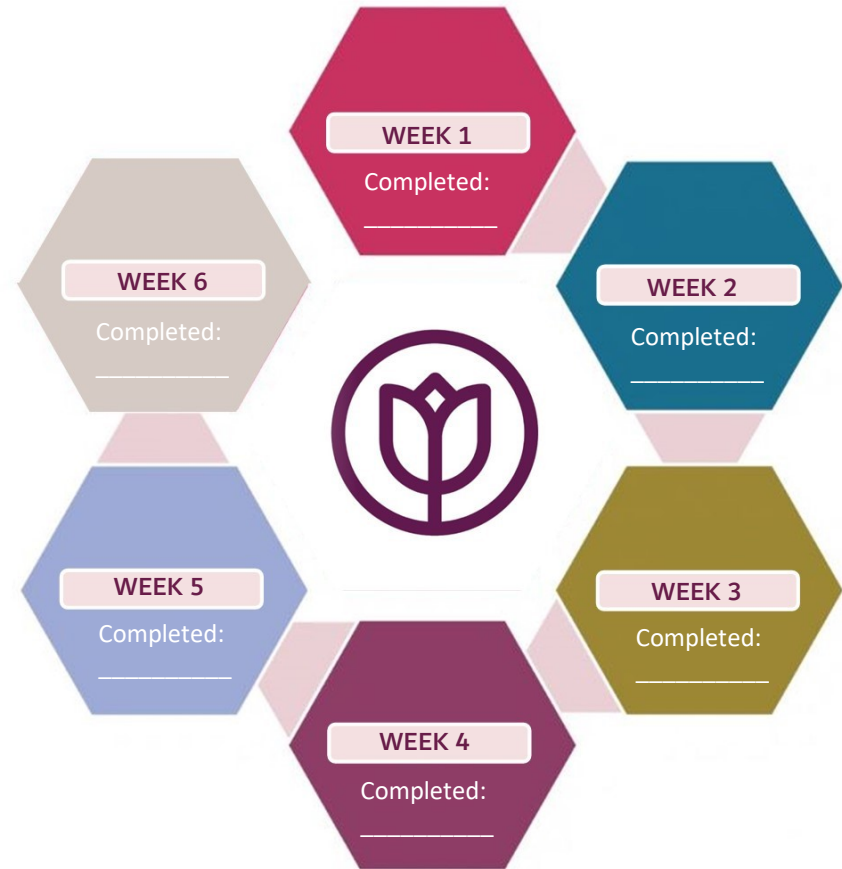
